4 BALL AMBROSE SCRAMBLE (Elimination)

This is played in teams of four – Handicap allowance 1/8th combined.

- All team members tee off each hole
- The team chooses the ball they are going to use for the second shot and the others are picked up. The team must choose each player's tee shot (on a par 4 or par 5 hole) at least 3 times during the round.
- Apart from the golfer whose ball is chosen (who is eliminated and does not play the second shot) each of the other team members places their ball within a club's length of the chosen ball but not nearer the hole (in the rough the ball is dropped rather than placed) and plays the second shot.
- A player is only eliminated for the shot following their ball being chosen, so will play the third shot in place of the player whose ball is chosen for that shot.
- This process continues until the chosen ball is on the putting green, and then all four players have the opportunity to sink the putt from within 15 cms (not nearer the hole) of the position of the chosen ball.
- All team members tee off the next hole and the elimination process begins again, until a ball is chosen on the next putting green
- The eliminated player cannot take a practice shot during the time they are eliminated
- The team handicap allowance is the total of the team's individual handicaps divided by 8

Note

A hole is over once a team ball is in the hole so a ball should **not be** holed out until all players have attempted their putt.

A variation of this format (also known as Texas Scramble) is where <u>all</u> players play every shot i.e. there is no elimination
