4 BALL AMBROSE

A stroke or stableford event played as a team of four – Handicap allowance – 1/8th combined handicaps

- All players tee off on every hole
- The team chooses which ball they will use for the second shot and the others are picked up. The team must choose each player's tee shot (on a par 4 or par 5) at least 3 times during the round.
- The player whose ball is chosen, plays his second shot followed by each of his/her team members who place their ball within a club's length of the chosen ball but not nearer the hole (in the rough the ball is dropped rather than placed).
- Again, the team chooses a ball for their third shot and play their third shots from the position of the chosen ball as before.
- Play continues in this manner until the ball chosen is on the putting green then each player has the opportunity to sink the putt from within 15 cms of the position (not nearer the hole) of the chosen ball.

Note

The hole is over once a team ball is in the hole so a ball should not be holed out until all players have attempted their putt.
