

## PINK LADY TEAM

This is a 4 player team game usually combined with individual stableford. Each team is supplied with a 'team ball' which might be pink or some other distinctive colour

- Player A marks the team card. The team score on each hole is the sum of the score with the pink ball and the best two other scores.
- Player A plays the pink ball on Hole 1, Player B on Hole 2, Player C on Hole 3, and Player D on Hole 4. This rotation is continued throughout the 18 holes.  
Players A and B will therefore play 5 holes each with the pink ball, Players C and D only 4 each.
- In a shotgun start, if you start on a hole other than the first, e.g., the third, then the player due to play the pink ball (in this case Player C) does so.
- On any hole, if there is no score with the pink ball only the two other best scores count.
- If the pink ball is lost there can be no further pink ball scores and only the best two scores from the players not due to play the pink ball should be totalled for each subsequent hole.
- The pink ball must be returned with the completed card
- Mark your card as shown below

1. Show each team member's **stableford** score for each hole
2. Show total points **as pink ball score plus two best other scores**
