ECLECTIC

There are two eclectic seasons winter and summer.

- An eclectic score is the cumulative total of the member's lowest <u>Gross</u> score on each hole from qualifying cards submitted during the season
- The Handicapper records these scores on a spreadsheet which is published monthly on the Club website.
- The season winner is the player with the lowest overall <u>Nett</u> score in each grade after deducting half the player's current handicap i.e. the handicap at the end of the season
- The winning Eclectic score must have a score recorded for every hole
